

Distinguished Club Program (simplified)

Membership	+	Goals	=	Recognition Earned
Either 20+ members (charter strength) OR a net growth of at least five new, dual, or reinstated members from your July 1 st membership base*	+	Achieve five of 10 goals	=	Distinguished Club
		Achieve seven of 10 goals		Select Distinguished Club
		Achieve nine of 10 goals		President's Distinguished Club

*The net growth of five applies to clubs with a membership base of 8-15. If a club has a membership base of 16-19, then that club needs to have 20 members (charter strength) at a minimum.

2016-2017 Example #1: Allegheny Mountains membership base is 11 as of July 1, 2016. In addition to achieving 5 or more goals, they also need to have membership to date of 16 in order to earn Distinguished or better. Allegheny Mountains membership to date is 17 and they earned seven goals as of June 30, 2017. Allegheny Mountains **did** earn Select Distinguished Club.

2016-2017 Example #2: Elk County membership base is 14 as of July 1, 2016. In addition to achieving 5 or more goals, they also need to have membership to date of 19 in order to earn Distinguished or better. Elk County added 6 new members throughout the year, but lost members. Elk County membership to date is 16 and they earned eight goals as of June 30, 2017. Elk County does not have a net growth of five; Elk County **did not** earn Select Distinguished Club.
