Internet privacy and security is something very important in today's online world. Toastmasters provides options at the club level, District, and International levels for respecting and maintaining your privacy. Each of these options is independent of the other. For example, if you opt-out of Toastmasters International emails, you may still receive emails at the Club and District level.

Clubs using the FreeToastHost web service are required to have you opt-in to receiving emails before you can be contacted via the club website. When you join a club, ask the VP of Membership if the club site requires you to opt-in, so you can ensure this email doesn't go to your spam folder.

District newsletters provide valuable information of the events, deadlines, and happenings with your fellow clubs and Toastmasters in District 13. However you have the option to remove yourself from the distribution list.

www.toastmasters.org gives you access to a broad range of information about your account and your interactions with Toastmasters International for the limited purpose of viewing and, in certain cases, updating that information. Examples of data you can access at www.toastmasters.org include your order history and personally identifiable information (including name, email, password, and your club membership history). You may choose not to provide data and opt out of services and communications along the way, but certain services, may be unavailable to you as a result. More details on the opt-out options available when you log into www.toastmasters.org are listed below:

YOUR NAME ON PUBLIC REPORTS

Toastmasters International creates a number of reports for various purposes, including education tracking, which are used by club officers and district leaders. Member names are visible on these reports, but you have the right to be anonymous.
